

Pam's thirty year career in fundraising began at her alma mater, Stone Ridge School of the Sacred Heart in Bethesda, Maryland, where she served as the first Director of Alumnae Relations. She was later named the Director of Annual Giving at Hood College. Returning to Catholic education, Pam accepted the Director of Development position at Mount St. Mary's University and for 14 years, she was privileged to serve both President George Houston and President Thomas Powell. Since her retirement in 2010, her involvement with Catholic education in Frederick County has continued as a member of the boards at the Visitation Academy, Saint John's Catholic Prep and most recently as the Chairman of the Frederick County Catholic Schools Coordinating Committee.
